

In assessing the photos and models, we will also be looking at the symmetry of your face, your facial tone and structure and the colour and shape of your existing teeth. Through this process we will spend time listening to you, asking about your lifestyle, the foods you enjoy, your health and your diet in general. This process is vital to get the right outcome for you, as it enables us to create a smile that will last.

SMILE ASSESSMENT

This is your chance to tell us exactly what you want to achieve so we can begin to design your beautiful new smile with a clear understanding of your desired outcome. At Portmore we have a comprehensive checklist of factors we consider when designing your new smile:

- Smile symmetry
- Shape of teeth
- Size of teeth

- Gum levels
- Angle of teeth
- Spaces between teeth
- Reflection of light
- Lip posture
- Translucency

When all of these elements are taken into consideration, using our state of the art digital smile design technology our highly skilled dentists use their knowledge, skill and artistic ability to create a natural looking smile that you will be proud to show off at every opportunity.

CREATE THE BLUEPRINT AND START TO MAKE YOUR DREAMS A REALITY

You can choose a combination of treatments including veneers, aesthetic bonding, ceramic crowns, teeth whitening, even braces or clear aligners – whatever you want to create your dream smile.

We spend a lot of time in your initial consultation assessing your facial form and features, taking x-rays, 3D scans, clinical photographs and studying models of your existing teeth. We then work closely with our laboratory technician in order to plan your new smile. It may be that you meet the senior lab technician who will be creating your smile in order for them to to assess your facial features 'in the flesh' and get a feel for your personality and desired result.

SMILE PREVIEW

Often, we will create a diagnostic wax-up, which means that we are able to show you the final result in wax before treatment begins. We find this is a crucial communication tool that enables us to be clear about your expectations and your desired result.

At this point you can decide on any final alterations regarding colour and tooth shape before the final restorations are completed in the laboratory.

TREATMENT PREDICTABILITY

One of the advantages and a real asset we find is that you'll already know what your smile is going to look like regardless of the complexities of the treatment involved. Not only does this help to put your mind at rest, it also means that dentist, patient and laboratory technician are on the same page and committed to achieving the same result.

SAME DAY WHITE TEETH

Using CEREC a revolutionary computer-aided design and manufacturing technique, which is transforming the nature of restorative dentistry. Ceramic restorations such as crowns and veneers can be measured, created and fitted during a single visit.

This process enables us to design, produce and place individual ceramic restorations in far less time than traditional methods

Using an intraoral camera to capture images of the tooth to be restored we are able to custom-design and create a detailed digital model of the tooth restoration in real time. This is transmitted wirelessly to a milling machine, which manufactures the restoration from colour-matched ceramic material in as little as 60 minutes.

BENEFITS OF SAME DAY WHITE TEETH WITH CEREC

- A single visit saves you time
- Digital impressions are faster and more comfortable than the traditional method, helpful for patients who find impressions difficult to tolerate due to a strong gag reflex
- Clinical studies show a 95.5% success rate after nine years
- Extremely accurate fit, normally requiring less follow up work than traditional restorative techniques
- Ceramic restorations have a natural looking appearance

VENEERS

Dental veneers are a mainstay of cosmetic dentistry because they can transform your confidence by creating a beautifully white and straight smile. They are fine slivers of porcelain that are bonded over your existing tooth to cover imperfections and to create the illusion of straighter teeth.

Over time, it is normal for your teeth to become discoloured, misshapen or to move or rotate slightly, especially if you have lost teeth. They can also get worn down, fractured and chipped due to everyday wear and tear. Using veneers we can close gaps, repair worn and chipped teeth and create the illusion of straight teeth where they were once crooked. For patients with deep enamel staining or bands of grey running through their teeth that cannot be removed, veneers offer the only route to whiter teeth. There are many elements that make up a beautiful, natural looking smile, such as symmetry, and the ideal shape and size of teeth. Our dentists and laboratory technicians will study your skin colour and pallor to help you choose a natural looking shade of white for you. The process to prepare and fit your new veneers can take as little as 10 days.



BENEFITS OF VENEERS

- They can create the illusion of straight teeth without the need for braces
- They hide imperfections such as chips, stains and yellowing
- They are hard wearing and with the right care should last for 15 years
- They are stain resistant
- Results can be achieved in as little as 2 weeks

AESTHETIC BONDING

Sometimes, tooth whitening alone is not enough to restore a smile. Dental bonding is often used to repair small chips or cracks and cover up troublesome stains. We apply a thin coat of acrylic resin to your teeth which is sculpted as it hardens so that it evenly covers and fills the damaged areas.

The acrylic or composite is meticulously matched to the natural shade of your teeth. The results will look so natural that even you may not be able to tell which teeth you've had work on.

BENEFITS OF AESTHETIC BONDING

- Little to no removal of enamel; 'non-invasive' dentistry
- Retains the health and natural structure of your tooth
- Less extensive procedure than restorations like porcelain veneers or dental crowns
- Can usually be completed in one appointment

Teeth whitening treatments are now amongst the most asked for cosmetic dental treatments and can transform the appearance of your teeth in a matter of hours giving you a glossy, healthy looking smile. At Portmore we have carefully selected what we consider to be the safest and best products available to offer you a comprehensive range of whitening treatments, guaranteeing incredible results. Premium home whitening products. Home whitening kits remain the treatment of choice for many patients wanting to whiten their teeth in the comfort of their own home. The home whitening brands we use provide consistent results with the added benefit that you can whiten your teeth anytime, anywhere when the inclination suits! Home tooth whitening can also be 'topped up' at regular intervals which makes it great value for money and see's long-lasting results.

ORTHODONTICS

At Portmore, we use cosmetic orthodontic systems such as Invisalign and Six Month Smiles to move teeth in a shorter time than traditional orthodontics.

These popular teeth straightening systems can be a good alternative to traditional metal braces because they use clear materials so are less noticeable in the mouth, which can appeal to people who want to look their best throughout treatment. Cosmetic brace systems are especially suited to adults who are concerned about the cosmetic issues that misaligned teeth may cause rather than functional issues; these systems tend to concentrate on aligning the upper and lower 6 teeth. For patients whose teeth or jaws have more complex functional issues surrounding misaligned or crowded teeth, we are able to refer them to an on-site specialist orthodontist for more comprehensive treatment.

INVISALIGN

Invisalign is a well known removable aligner system that can fix mild to moderate cases of misalignment. Your Invisalign clear aligners are custom-made for you. The aligners are virtually invisible and fit snugly over your teeth. Each aligner shifts your teeth slightly, moving them horizontally and vertically and even rotating them when needed.

- No metal brackets or wires
- Discreet and easier to maintain than traditional braces

SIX MONTH SMILES

Six Month Smiles is a cosmetic teeth straightening treatment that can give you the smile you've always wanted in an average time of six months, far quicker than traditional braces, which can take up to two years.

With clear brackets and tooth coloured wires based on proven orthodontic techniques, this option is also more discreet than traditional fixed metal braces.

As with any teeth straightening treatment, a retainer is necessary afterwards to maintain the position of your teeth. This will either be a fixed or removable retainer, depending on your case.



BENEFITS OF SIX MONTH SMILES

- Average treatment time of six months — ideal if you're looking to meet a deadline such as a forthcoming wedding
- They're discreet, with clear brackets and tooth coloured wire, so no one will notice you're wearing braces
- Gentle pressure and short overall treatment time means increased comfort, safety and oral hygiene

HOW LONG WILL A SMILE MAKEOVER TAKE?

Your smile makeover is a custom made plan just for you. Depending on what you want to change, your plan might involve a combination of dental implants, teeth whitening, veneers, orthodontics and cosmetic bonding. As there could be any number of treatments involved, each with their own expected time frame, it's difficult to say how long the process will take. However, no matter how long it takes you can be certain that your plan will leave you with the smile you have always wanted.

AM I SUITABLE FOR A SMILE MAKEOVER?

Most people can benefit from a smile makeover, however if you are in poor oral health and suffer from issues such as tooth decay or gum disease it would be important to address these issues before beginning your smile makeover.
